### BOSTON POLICE DEPARTMENT



Boston PD is hosting a Full-Scale Training Exercise at Fenway Park on Sunday, 12 June 2016, from 7 a.m. to 1 p.m.

The exercise will include a realistic terrorist scenario with simulated gun shots and explosions. Law enforcement has been actively involved in the planning of this exercise and will play the roles of both attackers and response teams.

Registration will occur at the Boston Arts Academy across from Fenway Park at 7:00 a.m. All role players will be required to present an ID, sign a waiver, and participate in a pre-exercise safety briefing and weapons check prior to entering the exercise area. Cell phones will need to be turned off while within the exercise area.

Role players will be asked to execute 'run' and 'hide' protocols, as well as simulate casualties. We will be requesting volunteers to be 'mouled', or made up, however, keep in mind that doing so may cause your clothing to be ruined. Those who volunteer to play casualties may be 'treated' by responding Emergency Medical Service (EMS) personnel.

All role players will be required to sign a waiver to participate.
