ABSTRACT: Training to be held at Reed Rico Industrial Dr Holden Ma. . Videos from MFA (Massachusetts Firefighting Academy) on proper ladder selection, placement and techniques along with proper commands to be viewed by department members via email/youtube. To be viewed prior to practical training.

EQUIPMENT: 16' straight/roof ladder, 20' straight/roof ladder, 24' Extension ladder and 35' Extension ladder

Station 1: 16' straight ladder single person raise

Equipment : 16' roof/straight ladder

Objective :

1. Members will correctly pick up ladder and carry it to the building.
2. Members will use appropriate ladder raise as in videos.
3. Members will appropriately place ladder against building for assignment. (Vent, Firefighting or Rescue)
4. Members will appropriately lower ladder and return properly.

Station 2: 24' Extension ladder single person raise

Equipment : 24' Extension ladder

Objective :

1. Members will correctly pick up ladder and carry it to the building.
2. Members will use appropriate ladder raise as in videos.
3. Members will appropriately place ladder against building for assignment. (Vent, Firefighting or Rescue)
4. Members will appropriately lower ladder and return properly.

Station 3: 24' Extension ladder two person raise

Equipment : 24' Extension ladder

Objective :

1. Members will correctly pick up ladder and carry it to the building, working as a team using the proper commands.
2. Members will use appropriate ladder raise as in videos, working as a team using proper commands.
3. Members will appropriately place ladder against building for assignment (Vent, Firefighting or Rescue), working as a team using proper commands.
4. Members will appropriately lower ladder and return properly, working as a team using proper commands.

Station 4: 35' Extension ladder three person raise w/ roof ladder deployment

Equipment : 35' Extension ladder and 16' or 20' roof ladder

Objective :

1. Members will correctly pick up ladder and carry it to the building, working as a team using the proper commands
2. Members will use appropriate ladder raise as in videos, working as a team using proper commands
3. Members will appropriately place ladder against building for assignment (Roof Ops.)
4. Members will appropriately carry and deploy roof ladder, working as a team and using proper commands.
5. Members will remove roof ladder and return properly, working as a team using proper commands.
6. Members will appropriately lower ladder and return properly, working as a team using proper commands.
