Eligibility

- Applicant must reside in EMS Region II (a map of towns in Region II [Central Mass] is located at the website: <https://www.cmemsc.org/index.php/cmed-tower-hospital-map>)
- Applicant must be 18 yrs or older upon completion of the program
- Applicant must meet all the eligibility requirements of an EMT per MA [105 CMR 170](#)
- Applicant must maintain a passing grade throughout the program

Program Criteria and Financial Information

- Accelerated EMT program schedule: **Tuesday, Wednesday, Thursday** nights: 6-10 pm; **Saturday** 9am-5pm each week **May 10, 2022 through June 18, 2022**
- Awardee must have online access to complete some portions of the classwork
- Scholarship awardee will be responsible for purchase price of textbooks (up to \$350), due the first night of class. This will be *fully refunded upon successful completion of the course.*
- Cost of NREMT and MA state certification fees are not included in the scholarship (current fees: NREMT cognitive exam-\$98; state psychomotor exam-\$200; state certification fee-\$150)
