YTD ACTIVITY - 2810 (2150 EMERGENCY, 660 INSPECTION)

The Fire Department continues to respond to calls at a record pace. Over the 3rd quarter of 2022, a total of 842 calls for service were responded to. Overall, the department has seen a 20% rise in call volume since the start of 2022. The Fire Prevention Division was also busy conducting 256 Code Enforcement inspections and plan reviews.

Our annual SAFE Open House is scheduled to be held on Tomorrow 10/15. We will be holding it in person for the first time since 2019, so the kids should be thrilled to come to the station and see all of our equipment! Thanks to those who have stepped up to help at the event and any other department member who wants to assist contact FF Sposato.

Vehicles

- 1. Engine 1: DPW is currently installing the new radiator and will be putting everything back together today. We hope to have it back in service by early next week.**
- 2. Engine 3: There is a reported Diesel fuel leak, speedy dry has been applied to the apparatus bay floor and DPW has been notified, hopefully will look at it today. The ladder rack was repaired yesterday after becoming stuck in the down position. If there are any further problems, please let a shift officer know.**

Training

- 1. We are still in the process of trying to secure a location for our Live Fire Training. We hope to schedule something in November and we will keep everyone updated.**
- 2. Over the last couple of weeks, we have been training at a town owned property on Princeton Street. This is a great training tool to have an actual multi-family home to train on multiple topics. We will continue to use it as long as we can prior to its demolition.**

Stations

- 1. Adams Road: Still no updated timeline for the DPW to move out of the building. They are awaiting equipment to put their new building online.**
