I am pleased to announce that the department has received the FY23 Firefighter Safety Equipment Grant from the Department of Fire Services in the amount of \$19,000. For this grant, we will be upgrading our air bag cache, purchase new Ice Rescue equipment and purchase a new Blitz Gun to be placed on E1. Great work by all who took part in writing this grant.

1. Engine 1 – Antifreeze leak was found yesterday and repaired.
