DEPARTMENT UPDATES 1/5/24 –1/19/24

After the holidays, it is a very slow time for news worthy items. Recently, the Asst. Chief and I took part in a tabletop exercise at Anna Maria College. This exercise was the first step in a full-scale ASHER drill to be held by West Boylston Fire at the Worcester County House of Corrections on 6/10/24. This drill will bring together Fire, EMS, Law Enforcement and School Districts from throughout our area to take part in live role playing scenarios. The building to be used is modeled after a typical school building and will bring some realism to the event. The tabletop drill was very interesting as it allowed us to see where all of the other departments are in their ASHER planning. We will be looking for department members to take part in this drill and will be reaching out once WBFD lets us know what resources they will need from HFD.

Budget season is rolling along with both the General Fund and Capital budgets submitted. We did take a step back recently as town departments were asked to significantly reduce our Capital requests for FY25. As for our department, we were able to reduce a couple of projects and identified alternate funding streams to move forward with them. This allows our department to have no direct effect of the reduction in Capital funding to this point.
