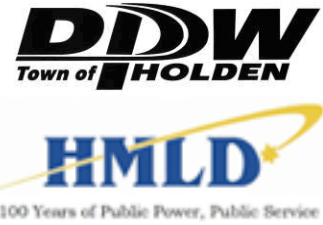

Weekly Road Construction Update

The following are the planned major work activities by Town of Holden Departments. The work schedule is subject to change based upon weather and other factors. Activities may be added or subtracted dependent on those factors. Neighborhoods directly impacted by the planned work will be separately notified by the Town's CodeRED system, and updates may be found on the Town's Facebook page. Department of Public Works

Highway Division

- On Monday 7/8 to Friday 7/12 the Highway Division will be making drainage repairs on Mt. Pleasant Ave. The road will be closed to through traffic from Main St (Route 122A) to Princeton St.

Water & Sewer Division

- Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of July 8th.

Light Department

Line Division

- 7/8 (DOT Project) Chapel St. w/detail officers
- 7/9 (DOT Project) Transferring utility poles on Doyle Rd. w/detail officers.
- 7/10, 7/11, 7/12 crews will be working on Mount Pleasant Ave.

Forestry Division

- 7/8-12 GML Contractor will be trimming on Malden St. w/details
- No road closures are currently scheduled

Known Outside Agency and Private Work

MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

- The grinding of the road is expected to start on Sunday, July 21st. Work will be performed at night, Sunday night through Thursday night for +/- 7 shifts total. They will be starting at the Holden State Police Barracks proceeding North/West on Main Street (Route 122A).
- The contractor plans on finishing the concrete sidewalks by this Friday, July 12th.
- As an aside, utility work to begin at 788 Main Street on Monday, July 8th.

MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- E.H. Perkins will continue drainage work on Shrewsbury Street, between Holden Street and Doyle Road, and will continue to use the detour of southbound (outbound) traffic on Shrewsbury Street onto Holden Street, to Brentwood Drive to Brattle Street. Drainage work may also occur along Holden Street and Chapel Street.

Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

- The contractor for Eversource Gas will be working in Holden Street near Marlen Road and in Shrewsbury Street between Wachusett Street and Holden Street. Shrewsbury Street northbound (inbound) traffic will be detoured at Chapel Street, to Malden Street, to Main Street, similar to the past several weeks.
