Department of Public Works

Highway Division

• On Monday 7/15 to Friday 7/19 the Highway Division will continue making drainage repairs on Mt. Pleasant Ave. The road will be closed to through traffic from Main St (Route 122A) to Princeton St.

Water & Sewer Division

• Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of July 15th.

Light Department

Line Division

• Various locations, but no road closures are currently scheduled

Forestry Division

- 7/15-19 GML Contractor will continue trimming on Malden St. w/details
- Various locations, but no road closures are currently scheduled

Known Outside Agency and Private Work

MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

• The grinding of the road is expected to start on Sunday, July 21st. Work will be performed at night, Sunday night through Thursday night for +/- 7 shifts total. They will be starting at the Holden State Police Barracks proceeding North/West on Main Street (Route 122A).

MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- E.H. Perkins will continue working on Doyle Road between Shrewsbury Street and Brattle Street. Doyle Road traffic will be detoured in both directions via Brattle Street and Shrewsbury Street.
- E.H. Perkins may continue drainage work on Shrewsbury Street in the vicinity of Mountview Middle School. Outbound (eastbound) traffic may be detoured onto Holden Street to Brentwood Drive to Brattle Street.
- Drainage work may also occur along Holden Street and Chapel Street.
- Concrete prep work may begin on Wachusett Street between Lincoln Avenue and Shrewsbury Street, resulting in a detour to Lincoln Avenue.

Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

• The contractor for Eversource Gas will continue working in Holden Street near Shrewsbury Street. The expectation is to maintain two-way traffic on Holden Street with a lane shift.
