Weekly Road Construction Update



Week of July 22nd 2024

The following are the planned major work activities by Town of Holden Departments. The work schedule is subject to change based upon weather and other factors. Activities may be added or subtracted dependent on those factors. Neighborhoods directly impacted by the planned work will be separately notified by the Town's CodeRED system, and updates may be found on the Town's Facebook page. Department of Public Works

Highway Division

- On Monday, July 22nd the Highway Division will finish drainage repairs on Mt. Pleasant Ave. The road will be closed to through traffic from Main St (Route 122A) to Princeton St.
- Tuesday, July 23rd to Friday, July 26th the Highway Division will be making drainage repairs on Quinapoxet Street between Fairview Avenue and Princeton Street. Traffic will be detoured through Fairview Avenue.

Water & Sewer Division

- Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of July 22nd.

Light Department

Line Division

- Various locations along Doyle Road, Brattle Street, Holden Street, and Chapel Street but no road closures are currently scheduled

Forestry Division

- Various locations trimming vine growth in The Maze, but no road closures are currently scheduled

Known Outside Agency and Private Work

MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

- The grinding of the road is expected to start on Sunday, July 21st. Work will be performed at night, Sunday night through Thursday night for +/- 7 shifts total. They will be starting at the Holden State Police Barracks proceeding North/West on Main Street (Route 122A).

MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- E.H. Perkins will continue working on Doyle Road between Shrewsbury Street and Brattle Street. Doyle Road traffic may be detoured in one or both directions via Brattle Street and Shrewsbury Street.
- Work will begin on Wachusett Street between Lincoln Avenue and Shrewsbury Street, resulting in a detour to Lincoln Avenue.

Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

- The contractor for Eversource Gas will continue working in Holden Street near Shrewsbury Street. The expectation is to maintain two-way traffic on Holden Street with a lane shift, but traffic may need to be detoured through Marlen Road and Homestead Road.
