Department of Public Works

Highway Division

• Monday, July 29th to Friday, August 2nd the Highway Division will continue making drainage repairs on Quinapoxet Street between Fairview Avenue and Princeton Street. Traffic will be detoured through Fairview Avenue though Wednesday, possibly until Thursday.

Water & Sewer Division

• Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of July 29th.

• Various locations but no road closures are currently scheduled

Forestry Division

• Various locations but no road closures are currently scheduled

Known Outside Agency and Private Work

MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

• The grinding of the roadway surface is complete. Adjustments to manholes and catch basins will take several weeks. Work will continue on sidewalks.

MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- E.H. Perkins will continue working on Doyle Road between Shrewsbury Street and Brattle Street. Doyle Road traffic may be detoured in one or both directions via Brattle Street and Shrewsbury Street. The detour will shift back to Doyle Road when the crew begins work on Brattle Street north of Doyle Road.
- Work is ongoing on Wachusett Street between Lincoln Avenue and Shrewsbury Street, resulting in a detour to Lincoln Avenue.

Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

• The contractor for Eversource Gas will continue working in Shrewsbury Street between Holden Street and Tyler Drive. Expect traffic to be detoured through Homestead Road and Marlen Road eastbound and through Red Barn Road and Tyler Drive westbound. The expectation is to maintain two-way traffic on Holden Street with a lane shift.
