# **Department of Public Works**

## **Highway Division**

• The Highway Division will be working on portions of Quinapoxet St next week and may need to close the road. If road closures are necessary the detour will be Main St to Rt 31.

## Water & Sewer Division

• Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of August 12<sup>th</sup>.

#### **Light Department**

#### Line Division

- On Monday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, crews will be working on transfers on Holden Street poles in front of HMLD with the assistance of traffic control details.
- On Tuesday, August 13<sup>th</sup>, crews will be working on Causeway Street.
- For the remainder of the week, line crews will be working various locations within MassDOT projects.
- No road closures are expected all week.

#### Forestry Division

- On Monday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, Forestry will be assisting Highway along Quinapoxet St. and Mt. Pleasant Ave.
- Various other locations but no road closures are currently scheduled.
- GML contracted tree crews will be on Salisbury Street all week with traffic control details.

#### **Known Outside Agency and Private Work**

#### MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

• Adjustments to manholes and catch basins will continue for several weeks. Work will continue on sidewalks.

#### MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- Work continues on the retaining wall on Wachusett Street between Lincoln Avenue and Shrewsbury Street, resulting in a detour to Lincoln Avenue.
- Beginning on Monday, August 12<sup>th</sup>, E.H. Perkins' drainage crew will return to Holden Street between Shrewsbury Street and Marlen Road. Holden Street will be closed in the southbound direction, northbound should remain open. Southbound traffic will be detoured via Homestead Road and Marlen Road until Wednesday or Thursday.
- Beginning on Wednesday, August 14<sup>th</sup> or Thursday, August 15<sup>th</sup>, E.H. Perkins' drainage crew will relocate to Chapel Street. Chapel Street traffic will be detoured via Red Barn Road and Tyler Drive.

#### Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

- The contractor for Eversource Gas will be digging test holes on Main Street from Shrewsbury Street to the State Police barracks. Northbound Main Street traffic will be shifted over to the southbound lane. Southbound traffic will be diverted onto the Shrewsbury Street turn lane. Traffic will be allowed to turn right onto Main Street at the traffic signal during the detour.
- The contractor for Eversource Gas will also be digging test holes on Shrewsbury Street from Main Street towards South Wachusett Street. Two-way traffic will be maintained with a lane shift and traffic control details.
