Weekly Road Construction Update



Week of August 26th 2024

The following are the planned major work activities by Town of Holden Departments. The work schedule is subject to change based upon weather and other factors. Activities may be added or subtracted dependent on those factors. Neighborhoods directly impacted by the planned work will be separately notified by the Town's CodeRED system, and updates may be found on the Town's Facebook page. Department of Public Works

Highway Division

- On Monday August 26th and/or Tuesday the 27th, contracted tree crews will be working on Mount Pleasant Street, resulting in a detour onto Princeton Street.
- On Thursday August 29th and Friday the 30th, the Highway Division will be working on Quinapoxet St drainage structures. Traffic may be detoured via Main St and Rt 31.

Water & Sewer Division

Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of August 26th.

Light Department

Line Division

• The Line Division will be working on various projects. No road closures or detours are expected.

Forestry Division

- Tree crews will be on Salisbury Street all week with traffic control details.
- Various other locations but no road closures are currently scheduled.

Known Outside Agency and Private Work

MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

- Adjustments to manholes and catch basins will continue through the end of August. Work will continue on sidewalks. Lane shifts around the work zones are to be expected.
- Leveling and grading of Main Street and side street approaches will continue through the end of August. Top course paving is expected to begin early/mid-September.

MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- Wachusett Street remains closed between Lincoln Avenue and Shrewsbury Street, resulting in a detour to Lincoln Avenue.
- Curb work will begin on the south side of Shrewsbury Street from Main Street to Holden Street. Eastbound (outbound) traffic is expected to shift to the westbound side. Westbound (inbound) traffic may be detoured to Chapel Street and Malden Street.
- Installation of new traffic signal conduit at the intersections of Shrewsbury Street and Main Street and Shrewsbury Street, Holden Street, and Chapel Street may result in additional lane shifts or short-term detours.

Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

• Monday, August 26th through Friday, August 30th, R.J. Devereaux, the contractor for Eversource Gas, will be working on Main Street from Shrewsbury Street to the State Police barracks. Northbound Main Street traffic will be shifted over to the southbound lane. Southbound traffic will be diverted onto the Shrewsbury Street turn lane. Traffic will be allowed to turn right onto Main Street at the traffic signal during the detour.
