#### **Department of Public Works**

## **Highway Division**

• Wednesday, September 4<sup>th</sup> through Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, Quinapoxet Street will be closed. Busses and emergency vehicles will be allowed through.

#### Water & Sewer Division

• Water & Sewer Division has no planned closures for the week of September 2<sup>nd</sup>.

## **Light Department**

#### Line Division

- The Line Division will be removing flags from Main Street poles on Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> and working on various projects for the rest of the week.
- No road closures or detours are expected.

## Forestry Division

- Tree crews will be on Salisbury Street all week with traffic control details.
- Various other locations but no road closures are currently scheduled.

## **Known Outside Agency and Private Work**

MassDOT (Main Street, Route 122A)

- Adjustments to manholes and catch basins will continue into the first week of September. Work will continue on sidewalks. Lane shifts around the work zones are to be expected.
- Leveling and grading of Main Street and side street approaches is ongoing. Top course paving is scheduled to begin Sunday night, September 8<sup>th</sup>.

## MassDOT (Shrewsbury Street-Doyle Road-Chapel Street-Holden Street Project)

- Wachusett Street remains closed between Lincoln Avenue and Shrewsbury Street, resulting in a detour to Lincoln Avenue.
- Installation of new traffic signal conduit on Holden Street at the intersections of Shrewsbury Street and Chapel Street may result in a short-term northbound (inbound) Holden Street detour via Marlen Road and Homestead Road.
- Curb work will continue on the south side of Shrewsbury Street from Main Street to Holden Street. Eastbound (outbound) traffic is expected to shift to the westbound side. Westbound (inbound) traffic may be detoured to Chapel Street and Malden Street.

#### Eversource Gas (Shrewsbury Street)

• Tuesday, September 3<sup>rd</sup> through Thursday, September 5<sup>th</sup>, R.J. Devereaux, the contractor for Eversource Gas, will be working nights (7:30 pm to 5:30 am) at the intersection of Main Street and Shrewsbury Street.

#### 515-541 Salisbury Street

• Wednesday, September 4<sup>th</sup> through Friday, September 6<sup>th</sup>, the private developer of 515-541 Salisbury Street will be making utility connections in the roadway and closing this section of Salisbury Street to through traffic. Through traffic will be detoured via Newell Road and Cranbrook Drive in both directions.
